PAUL THORN BAND CONTINUES TO PAVE ICONIC AMERICANA PATH WITH LIVE
PAY-PER-VIEW CONCERT

ANNOUNCES SPRING TOUR

Fresh off a boatload of year-end best-of accolades for his latest release “Pimps & Preachers,” Paul Thorn will host a full-length live pay-per-view concert on Sat., Jan. 29 at 8:00 pm CT. Along with his partners from Music Fog Productions, Paul will be webcasting the concert from Muscle Shoals, Alabama.

Starting today, fans can log on to www.paulthorn.com or www.musicfog.com and purchase tickets for the low price of \$6.99. Confirmation will be delivered via an email containing the concert URL. Following the live webcast, and through March 1, 2011, the concert video will continue to be available at the same URL, allowing repeated viewings by ticket holders.

Paul’s latest album, which gave him his first *Billboard* Top 100 debut and remained in the top five on the Americana Radio Airplay Chart for ten weeks, has been wowing critics. *Paste* said “the sacred and the profane pair nicely here, driven by Thorn’s dusky voice and subtle, often self-deprecating wit,” while the *Newark Star-Ledger* commented Thorn authors “succinct, epigrammatic verse that unsentimentally assays life’s common troubles,” and *The Nation* called the CD “an incredible find.” *Twangville.com* named the record it’s No. 1 Reader’s Pick for Best Album of 2010 and *TheAlternateRoute.com* included the CD in the Top 20 of all five of its critics’ Best of 2010 lists. *BluesRevue.com* and the *Memphis News Press*, among others, also included the record in their “Best of 2010” lists.
